THEME:

Creating Community Partnerships to Help Kids with Chalky Teeth

Through no fault of their own, about 1-in-5 kids have "chalky" back teeth whose enamel hasn't hardened properly. This developmental condition, called "molar hypomineralization (MH)", often leads to rapid tooth decay and extractions. The impacts of MH on affected families is complicated by widespread ignorance about this common condition. D3G's unique educational resources, including "Sam's Storybook", help raise public awareness. This novel 'Chalky Teeth Chat' networking event explores getting D3G resources into the hands of needy families through partnerships with community providers such as early childhood centres, schools, public health clinics and libraries.
