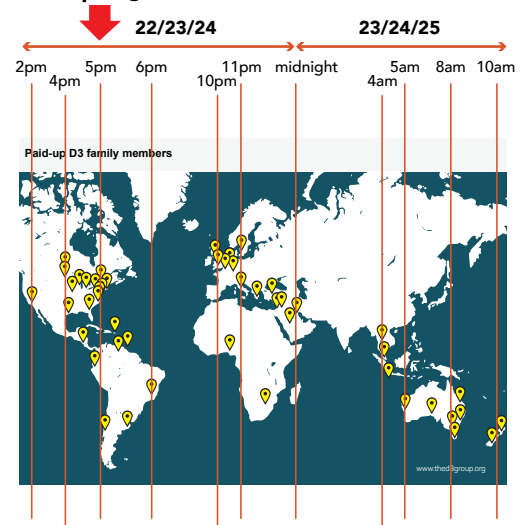

How can scientific & clinical advances be translated into classrooms, practice, healthcare policy and consumer markets? Universal curriculum, translational lingo?

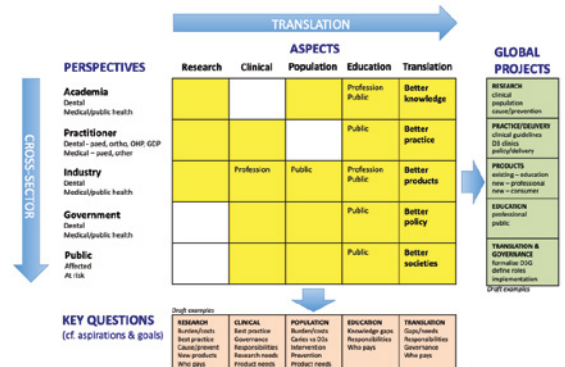
